1. After petition was heard for some time, by consent and without prejudice to the rights and contentions of the parties, following order is passed.

(d) Adjudication order shall be passed within a period of two weeks from the date of personal hearing.

(e) All rights and contentions are kept open to be raised in reply to this show cause notice and during personal hearing.

2. Petition accordingly stands disposed. Liberty to apply in case of non compliance by respondents.

3. Interim Application also disposed.
