1. By the present Petition, the Petitioner had prayed for his release on furlough leave.

Learned A.P.P. submitted that, by an Order dated 20th October 2021 the Deputy Inspector General of Prisons, Central Prison, Aurangabad had granted permission to the Petitioner to be released on furlough leave on certain conditions including the condition to furnish sureties.
