2. On the complaint of the Petitioner/ Complainant, the District Collector has passed certain orders on 16 October 2019. One part of the complaint was dismissed. aside or stayed by the authority. Once such a communication is made by the Petitioner, the same will be looked into by the District Collector at the earliest.
