1. On expressing my disinclination to entertain the application, on considering the clear-cut role of the applicant emerging through the case of the prosecution as compiled in the charge-sheet, learned counsel seeks permission to withdraw the application.

2. Permission granted. The application stands disposed off, as withdrawn.

3. Learned counsel for the applicant is, however, perfectly justified in submitting that the applicant is incarcerated since 13/12/2016 and, therefore, trial should be expedited.
