1. Present petition is filed seeking directions to Respondent authorities on the backdrop of a communication submitted to Dy. Registrar of Societies, Thane - Respondent no.1, dated 7th June 2022. Learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Petitioner submitted that the petitioner and some members of co-operative housing society raised various grievances against one of the members of managing committee, who was holding the charge of society as secretary. On perusal of the communication dated 7th June 2022 it is revealed that the members submitted the said complaint / representation. An administrator was appointed to look after the affairs of society and recently election for the members of managing committee of society is declared. Copy of the election program is placed on record at Exhibit-I to the petition. In view of this change in circumstances, in our opinion, nothing

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survives in the petition. The petition, thus, has been rendered infructuous and the same is accordingly disposed of.

2. In case, post election if there is any grievance of the Petitioner, he is at liberty to raise his grievance before the competent forum including any judicial forum, as provided under the provisions of law. With these observations, writ petition is disposed of.
