By the present application, the Applicant – Petitioner has prayed for an amendment to petition by placing on record certain documents in the form of certificates issued by the competent authorities of the State of Maharashtra, namely, the revenue authorities as well as copy of an order passed by this Court in bunch of petitions. It is further submitted by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Applicant-Petitioner that as these documents support the claim made in petition, the Petitioner is desirous of amending the petition by incorporating the additional grounds along with consequential prayers which only further the case of Petitioner. It is submitted that by learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Petitioner that by the proposed amendment, the tenor of petition is not going to be changed as such no prejudice would be caused to the respondents by the proposed

amendments.

2. On perusal of documents annexed to the application, we find considerable merit in the submission of learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Applicant. Accordingly, the application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a). The petition is permitted to be amended within three weeks from today. Needless to state that copy of the amended petition be supplied to learned AGP within two weeks thereafter. In case upon receipt of copy of amended petition, learned AGP is desirous of filing any reply, the same to be filed within two weeks thereafter. Needless to state that pleadings be exchanged by learned counsel appearing for the respective parties well in advance.

3. Post the petition for further consideration on 5th August 2022.
