1. The Petition raises seriously disputed question of fact. The Petitioner was an employee of Respondent No. 5, Astrazeneca Pvt Ltd. He was relieved from service in 2018. The Petition makes all kinds of allegations against the 5th Respondent, the Petitioner's employer. There are factual allegations of wrong doing. We are expected to accept these as being unconverted and absolutely true. Everyone of these allegations will require proof.

2. The Petitioner made a complaint on 16th January 2019 to the Organization of Pharmaceutical Producers of India. This is not shown to be an instrumentality of the state amenable to the Writ

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jurisdiction of this Court under Article 12 of the Constitution of India.

3. This Petition cannot be entertained. The Writ Petition is rejected. There will be no order as to costs.
