1. It is an Application for condonation of delay moved by the Applicants / Appellants.
2. Heard Mr. Ashutosh Hasija i/b. Mr. Sachin S. Punde, learned counsel for the Applicants and Mr. N. B. Patil, learned AGP for the Respondent-State.
