**1.** Mr. S.S. Deshmukh, learned advocate appearing for Respondent nos.1 and 2 states that all the Petitioners (except Petitioner nos. 16, 17, 18 and 19) have executed registered document, by which right, title and interest with respect to the suit property stands transferred in favour of Respondent nos.1 and 2. **4.** In view of statement made by Mr. S.S. Deshmukh, learned advocate appearing for Respondent nos.1 and 2 that the Petitioners have settled the matter with Respondent nos. 1 and 2, writ petition is disposed of with no order as to costs.
