3. Learned AGP, on instructions from respondent no. 1, states that the order would be passed in the said inquiry proceedings within three weeks from today. Statement is accepted.

4. The order that would be passed by the inquiry officer shall be served upon the learned counsel for the respondent no. 8 within one week from the date of the passing the order. The aggrieved party will be at liberty to file appropriate proceedings.

5. It is made clear that this Court has not expressed any view on the proceedings initiated against the respondents. All contentions of the parties are kept open.

6. The Petitioner is directed to communicate this order to

the respondent no. 8 for his information.

7. The writ petition is disposed of in the aforesaid terms.
