1] Pleadings in para 3 of the Affidavit in reply dated 10th January 2022 filed by the Respondent read thus:-

“3. At the outset, although this Respondent does not have any objection to the transfer of Case No.6200091/DV/2020 pending the Ld. Magistrate’s 62nd Court at Dadar, Mumbai to the Hon’ble 2nd Family Court at Bandra, Mumbai and for the same to be heard and decided with Petition No.A-2107 of 2020 and Petition No.D-80 which are also currently pending before the Hon’ble 2nd Family Court at Bandra, Mumbai, *per se*, yet, it is most expedient to put the conduct of the Applicant on record.”

2] In view of pleadings in para 3 of the affidavit in reply, Application is allowed in terms of prayer clause (a). Prayer clause (a) reads as under:-

“a) This Hon’ble Court be pleased to transfer Case No.6200091/DV/2020 pending before the Ld. Magistrate’s 62nd Court at Dadar, Mumbai to the Hon’ble 2nd Family Court at Bandra, Mumbai and direct the same to be heard and decided with Petition No.A-2107 of 2020 and Petition No. D-80 pending before the 2nd Family Court, Bandra, Mumbai.”

3] As far as joint request of the parties for expeditious disposal of the proceedings is concerned, liberty to mention before the Court below.
