1. The learned APP has submitted that in the present case, the prosecution has examined 17 witnesses to bring home the guilt of the accused. It is pertinent to note that 4 persons were killed by the accused persons. The learned Sessions Judge has applied his mind while rejecting the application for bail on 16th October 2019 which is apparent from the fact that although the Special Public Prosecutor has given no objection to release the applicant/ accused no.4 on bail, The learned Sessions Court has categorically observed that it is not possible to separate role of each accused at this stage as the evidence of

witnesses categorically speaks about their involvement in the offence.
The offence is heinous.

2. In view of the fact that the trial is in progress, no case for bail is made out. Application stands dismissed and disposed of.
