2 Let the notice be served upon the applicant and the applicant shall act in aid of the said notice and shall report to the Investigating Officer within 7 days of it's receipt.

On his presence, the Officer-in-charge shall follow the procedure prescribed u/s.41-A of Cr.P.C and in case if he

comes to a conclusion that his custodial interrogation is necessary, he shall record the reasons to that effect. Before effecting his arrest, he shall give 72 hours notice in advance.
