After arguing for some time, when I expressed my disinclination to grant relief on merits, learned counsel for the Applicant prays for unconditional withdrawal of the application on merits of the matter. He submitted that directions to be issued to jail authorities to provide the latest medical report to the Applicant and liberty be granted to Applicant to prefer a fresh application only on medical grounds if her condition is so serious.

However, the Jail Superintendent is directed to give a copy of the latest medical report of the Applicant to the Applicant.
