This petition is filed seeking a direction to the Respondent – Authority to decide the representation of the Petitioner regarding transfer of the Petitioner who is working as a Teacher in the Zilla Parishad on the policy of keeping the working couple together.

2. The representation was made on 9 November 2021 and immediately within four days thereafter this writ petition is filed seeking a direction. In essence what the Petitioner seeks as a writ of mandamus which is premised on the fact that the Authority which was to act as per its duty has failed to do so. Not deciding a representation within a period of four days, in these facts, cannot be

considered as failure of duty warranting issuance of writ of mandamus. We do not approve of such petitions filed for directions immediately after making a representation. A writ of mandamus is not to be issued routinely irrespective of the fact situation.

3. All that we state that since this is a matter of transfer the concerned Authority will consider disposing of the same at an early date depending of course on the workload and the earlier time-bound commitments.

4. The Writ Petition is accordingly disposed of.
