1. The applicant face accusations in C.R. No. 0722 of 2022 which invoke Sections 384 r/w 34 of IPC.

Learned counsel for the applicant make a statement that he is not being served with a notice under section 41-A. Let the Investigating Officer abide by the directions issued by the Director General of Maharashtra State vide Standing Order No.3 of 2020 and issue him a notice under section 41-A of Cr.P.C.

2. On receipt of the notice, let the applicant report to the

Investigating Officer within a period of seven days from today. He shall render his co-operation to the Investigating Officer in the process of investigation.

On his presence, the Officer-in-charge shall follow the procedure prescribed u/s. 41-A of Cr.P.C and in case if he comes to the conclusion that his custodial interrogation is necessary, he shall record the reasons to that effect. Before effecting his arrest, he shall give 72 hours notice in advance.

3. Application is disposed off.
