1 By this petition, the only relief pressed for by the petitioners, is
amended prayer clause 30-ee, which reads thus :

“30-ee] Issue a writ of mandamus, or any other appropriate writ, order or directions in the nature of writ of mandamus, directing the respondent No. 1 to 3 to decide the

representation dated 08.02.2022 (Exhibit “V”) submitted by the petitioner within stipulated time by giving opportunity of hearing to the petitioner and for that purpose issue necessary orders.”

2 Learned counsel for the petitioners submits that the petitioners had made a representation dated 8th February 2022 to the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 and that the representation is not decided till date.

3 Mr. Bhate, learned counsel appearing for the respondent Nos. 1 to 3, on instructions, states that the alleged representation which is on page 91 of the petition, has not been received by the Authorities. He, however, submits that if a fresh representation is made to the said Authorities, the same will be considered in accordance with law.

4 At this stage, learned counsel for the petitioners states that he will file the same representation again before the said Authorities, within one week from today.

5 If such a representation is made by the petitioners before the said Authorities i.e. respondent Nos. 2 and 3, the respondent Nos. 2 and 3 to

decide the said representation as expeditiously as possible and in any event, within 12 weeks from the date of receipt of the said representation.

6 With the above directions, petition is disposed of.

7 It is made clear that we have not gone into the merits of the petition and as such, all contentions of all parties are kept open.

8 All concerned to act on the authenticated copy of this order.
