1. At the outset, learned APP makes a statement that at this stage the investigating agency does not want to arrest the Applicant. In case in future if certain material is available and if Applicant's custody is wanted, four clear working days notice will be given to the Applicant.

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2. Learned counsel for the Applicant in this situation does not press this application. However the statement made by the

learned APP is recorded and accepted. In case the investigating agency wants to arrest the Applicant in future, they shall give four clear working days notice to the Applicant to enable him to approach the appropriate Court for appropriate relief.
