P.C:-

1. Considering the nature of accusations levelled against the applicant in the FIR, which came to be registered, pursuant to a complaint lodged under section 156 (3) of Cr.P.C. resulting in registration of C.R. No. 488 of 2022, let the Investigating Officer adhere to the procedure prescribed in *Arnesh Kumar Vs. State of Bihar (2014) 8 SCC 273*. He shall issue notice under section 41-A of Cr.P.C to the applicant.
2. On receipt of the notice, let the applicant report to the Investigating Officer within a period of seven days from today. He shall render his co-operation to the Investigating Officer in the process of investigation.

On his presence, the Officer-in-charge shall follow the

procedure prescribed u/s. 41-A of Cr.P.C and in case if he comes to the conclusion that his custodial interrogation is necessary, he shall record the reasons to that effect. Before effecting his arrest, he shall give 72 hours notice in advance.

Application is disposed off.
