1. The present contempt petition is filed for non compliance of the order dated 30th March 2017. It can be briefly stated that the Petitioner is the project affected person and was entitled for allotment of land under a certain policy of State Government.

2. Today, learned AGP invited our attention to the communication dated 19th August 2022 received by her. Copy of the same is taken on record and marked "X" for identification. The perusal of this

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communication shows that a detailed order is passed by the Deputy Collector, Resettlement, Pune and certain lands are allotted to the Petitioner subject to certain conditions referred to in the said order. It is further stated in the order that Tahsildar, Khed, taulka Khed, district Pune to take appropriate steps immediately for implementation of the order by handing over possession of the land to the Petitioner. Direction is also given to Tahsildar to draw a necessary panchanama of handing over possession of the land to Petitioner. It is also directed to Tahsildar to take consequential steps such as necessary entries in the revenue record and submit action taken report within a time bound manner of eight days.

3. In view of above order and directions given to Tahsildar, learned counsel appearing on behalf of the Petitioner admits that the grievance raised in the petition no more survives. Accordingly, no further orders are required to be passed in this contempt petition. The contempt petition is accordingly disposed of.
