1] The learned APP states that the Investigating Officer made an attempt to serve notice under Section 41A of the Cr.P.C. upon the Applicant, but he was not found there.

2] The learned counsel for the Applicant makes a categorical statement that the Applicant is residing on the address mentioned in the title clause of the Application.

3] Let the Investigating Officer serve notice to the Applicant on the said address, within a period of three days from today. Upon receipt of the notice, the Applicant shall report to the Investigating Officer within a period of 7 days thereafter.

4] The Investigating Officer shall follow procedure prescribed under Section 41A of the Cr.P.C. and record reasons in case if he comes at a conclusion that custodial interrogation of the Applicant is very much necessary for completing the investigation. He shall also issue 72 hours notice in advance in case if he is desirous of effecting arrest.

With the abovesaid directions, Application is disposed off.
