1. Heard learned counsel for the applicant and learned APP for the State.
2. This is an application for pre-arrest bail for the offence punishable under Sections 135, 138, 150 of the Electricity Act, 2003 in connection with C.R.No.1054 of 2021 registered with Virar Police Station.

In case if the Investigating Officer wants to effect the arrest if he feels that arrest is imperative in the wake of the reasons recorded by him, he may effect the arrest after giving 72 hours notice in advance to the applicant. The applicant shall furnish the details of his residential address and phone numbers to the investigating officer.
