P.C:-

1 The learned APP on instructions of the Investigating Officer state that a notice u/s.41 A of Cr.P.C would be issued to the applicant since the offence alleged against him are punishable with Imprisonment for a period less than seven years.

2 Let such a notice be issued within a period of three days from today and the applicant shall respond to the said notice within the next 7 days. He shall render his co-operation to the Investigating Officer in the process of investigation.

3 On his presence, the Officer-in-charge shall follow the procedure prescribed u/s.41-A of Cr.P.C and in case if he

comes to a conclusion that his custodial interrogation is necessary, he shall record the reasons to that effect. Before effecting his arrest, he shall give 72 hours notice in advance.

Application is disposed off.
