. In pursuance of Order dated 10th November, 2022, the Commissioner of Police Mira-Bhayandar, Vasai-Virar Police Commissionerate, District Palghar has filed his affidavit dated 6th December, 2022. The said affidavit is accompanied with necessary documents including the directions issued by said Authority to the concerned Police Officer with respect to inquiry into ADR No.16 of 2022.
