- 1.** Heard learned counsel for the applicant.
- 2.** The pre-arrest bail is sought by the applicant in respect of an offence registered with Dharavi Police Station under sections 420, 34 of Indian Penal Code vide F.I.R. No. 1198 of 2022.
- 3.** Learned APP submitted that notice under section 41A of the Code of Criminal Procedure, 1973 ('CrPC', for short) was given to the applicant, but the applicant has not
