. Learned Advocate for Petitioner submitted that, in pursuance of Order dated 9th December 2022, the access of child was given by Respondent No.3 to the Petitioner on stipulated dates and timing mentioned therein.

5. We expect that, both the parties will adhere to the Consent Terms by taking into consideration the welfare of child.
