. This petition is moved for withdrawal.

2. The learned counsel for the Petitioners has produced an affidavit filed by the Petitioner No.1 Eknath Dhanu Kadav, stating that the Petitioners are desirous to withdraw the petition. The affidavit is accompanied by an irrevocable Power of Attorney (PoA) executed by the Petitioner Nos.2 to 5 in favour of the Petitioner No.1.
