This interim application seeks a direction against the liquidator to admit the maritime claim to the extent of Rs.8,21,284/- and to set aside order dated 3rd December, 2019 passed by the liquidator rejecting the claim. At the hearing today it has been made clear to the learned counsel for the applicant that the court cannot direct admission of the claim without an inquiry in the matter.

2. Learned counsel for the applicant states that he is willing to appear before the liquidator and make out his case if the order is set aside. The

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Liquidator no objection to that course of action. Accordingly I pass the following order :

- (i) Order dated 3rd December, 2019 at Exhibit K is set aside.
- (ii) Additional documents, if any shall be filed on or before 15th July, 2022
- (iii) Liquidator shall grant a fresh hearing on 11th August, 2022 at 12.00 noon provided additional documents are filed.
- (iv) If no additional documents are filed by 15th July, 2022 the matter will be heard and decided on that date.
- (v) Interim Application disposed in the above terms.
