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1. The Petitioner's Appeals against the orders of the Registrar of Trademarks would now lie before the learned Single Judge of this Court in view of the abolition of the IPAB and the transfer of all

IPAB appeals to the High Court. Liberty to the Petitioners to move the learned Single Judge for a hearing of the Appeals and all connected matters including any interim applications.

2. The Writ Petitions are disposed of as infructuous on that basis. We are making no observations on the merits of the controversy. All contentions are left open.

3. To save time, it is open to parties by consent to place before the learned Single Judge a compilation of the entire record before the IPAB instead of calling for the original record. Both sides must agree that the compilation is true copy of the record in the Appeals.

4. All concerned will act on production of a digitally signed copy of this order.
