1. Heard the learned Counsel for the parties.
2. The learned Counsel for Defendant No.2 submits that Noble Explochem Ltd. - Plaintiff no longer exists.
3. Pursuant to the orders passed by the National Company Law Tribunal, Mumbai Bench, on 22nd January, 2020 in Company Petition No.1758 of 2017, M/s. Ipca Laboratories Limited (IPCA) acquired the erstwhile Company - Noble Explochem Ltd., as a successful resolution applicant.
4. An Affidavit of Mr. Harish P. Kamath, Corporate Counsel and Company Secretary of IPCA is tendered. To the said Affidavit, copies of the orders passed by the NCLT, Mumbai are annexed. Mr. Kamath affirms that IPCA accords unconditional and irrevocable consent for withdrawal of the Suit in terms of the

resolution. Mr. Kamath is present in Court. He submits that IPCA does not wish to further prosecute the Suit.
