2. By this application, the applicant has sought to condone the delay of 344 days in filing the appeal under Section 54 of the Land Acquisition Act.

Having considered the reason stated in the application, which in my considered view, constitutes sufficient ground, the delay is condoned. Appeal to be registered after removal of office objections, if any. Application stands disposed of.
