2. Mr. Damle learned APP for non-applicant/State on the above ground does not having serious objections, for relaxation of the said condition for the above period, considering which,

condition no.(iv) which directs the applicant to reside beyond the territorial jurisdiction of village Goregaon for a period of six months from the date of the order i.e. 16.11.2021 is relaxed, for a period of 15 days from today and the applicant is permitted to visit and stay at village Goregaon for the purpose of performing post funeral rituals of his father on the condition that the applicant shall not indulge in any criminal activity during his stay at village Goregaon.
