Heard Mr. Meghe, learned counsel for the applicant. The petition came to be dismissed for non appearance by an order dated 11.01.2021 with a cost of Rs.10,000/-, which imposed the condition that if any application for restoration is preferred, the Registry shall ensure that the condition to deposit the cost is complied with.
