The learned Counsel for the Petitioners states that when this Petition was filed, the Debts Recovery Tribunal was not functioning. The learned Counsel further states that now the Debts Recovery Tribunal has become functional and seeks leave to withdraw the Petition to approach the Debts Recovery Tribunal.

2. The learned Counsel for the Petitioner states that the interim order dated 31 January 2020 passed in this Petition be continued for some time to enable the Petitioner to approach the Debts Recovery Tribunal.
