It appears that for just and sufficient reasons, the petitioner was not in a position to withdraw the amount deposited by the respondent 3 and could not avail of the liberty granted by this Court.

3. Learned Assistant Government Pleader, Ms. Khan states that if the cheque is returned to respondent 3, fresh cheque shall be issued and handed over to the petitioner directly.

5. The petitioner shall approach respondent 3 and handover the time barred cheque and the respondent 3 shall handover to the petitioner fresh cheque in its place.
