1. Heard the learned counsel for the petitioners.

It is stated on instructions that during the pendency of the petition, a Divisional Fee Regulatory Committee has been constituted, which is empowered to adjudicate upon the appeals filed before it, and therefore, request is made for grant of leave to withdraw the petition with appropriate liberty and directions regarding time bound decision by the Committee.
