The Petitioners are aggrieved by the order dated 10 July 2019 passed by the Maharashtra Administrative Tribunal in Original Application No.653/2017.

2) The Petitioners were not parties to the proceedings before the Tribunal. If it is the case of a party that it is aggrieved by the

order passed and is affected by it and was not a party to the proceedings, it is always open to such party to approach the court that passed the order – in this case the Tribunal - to seek recall of the order on that ground.
