The Appellant has been convicted by the impugned judgment dated 06.06.2022 for the offence punishable under Section 353 of the Indian Penal Code and sentenced to suffer simple imprisonment for three months and to pay a fine of Rs.15,000/- (Fifteen Thousand Only), and in default, to suffer further simple imprisonment for one month.

CRIMINAL APPLICATION NO.474 OF 2022.

5. By an order dated 06.06.2022, the learned Sessions Court had suspended the substantive sentence till the expiry of the Appeal period. Though, the

continuation of the said order is opposed by the learned APP, substantive sentence imposed by the learned Sessions Court is hereby suspended and the Applicant be released on his furnishing P. R. Bond in the sum of Rs.15,000/- with one solvent surety in the like amount.
