The petitioner desires to pursue further studies and hence she is in need of such adjudication.

3. It is informed that the Vigilance Enquiry has been conducted by the Scrutiny Committee.

4. In these facts, the Scrutiny Committee is directed to decide the petitioner's tribe claim within a period of three months from the

first date of appearance of the petitioner before the Scrutiny Committee. The petitioner shall through her father appear before the Scrutiny Committee on **11th July, 2022**
