When these petitions were called out for hearing, the learned counsel for the petitioners fairly states that as against the orders impugned before this Court, there is an alternative efficacious remedy available to the petitioners of filing a Revision Application under Section 9 of the Maharashtra Money Lending (Regulation) Act, 2014.
