We indicated to the learned counsel for the applicant that in view of the settled law *inter alia* (i) *State of Madhya Pradesh v. Laxmi Narayan and others (2019) 5 SCC 688*, (ii) *Narinder Singh and others v. State of Punjab and another (2014) 6 SCC 466* and (iii) *Gian Singh v. State of Punjab and another (2012) 10 SCC 303*, it would not be permissible for us to quash the prosecution under Section 376 of the IPC on the ground that the accused and the prosecutrix have arrived at amicable settlement.
