The petitioners have filed an affidavit dated 10.04.2022 stating therein that by the Government Resolution dated 03/03/2019, the government has increased the nourishment grant from Rs. 9,00/- to 1,500/-. Hence, the grievance of the petitioners towards enhancement and the arrears of
