Present application is filed for condonation of delay in filing application for restoration of second appeal. It appears that there is 33 days delay in filing application. The registration was refused for non removal of office objections. The reason given is that Counsel for appellant was out of station when the order came to be passed. It is submitted that due to inadvertent mistake, the office objection could not be removed.
