The present application is filed for condonation of delay in filing application for restoration of Second Appeal St. No.6035/2022 dismissed on 07/07/2022 for non removal of office objections. There is delay of 53 days in filing application for restoration of Second Appeal.

2. The reason given for delay is that the objections were not notified. In my considered opinion, as per the procedure, the Registrar (Judicial) used to display on notice board that the matter under objections and list is also circulated in the cause list.
