1] The appellant/State seeks leave to appeal against the judgment dated 15.6.2020, whereby the respondent has been acquitted of the offence under Sections s 353, 323, 504 of IPC (pg 18). It is contended that the finding of acquittal rendered based upon the observations in para 13 of the judgment in question, was not justified, considering which a case for leave is made out.
