The Petitioner has sought for a direction to direct Principal Judge, Family Court, Nagpur to dispose of the petition within a time bound period.

2. Even assuming a writ can be issued to the Family Court, we are not inclined to grant such direction as there would be pendency of older cases than the Petitioner's case.
