Heard Mr. Parmar, learned counsel for petitioner.

After hearing learned counsel for the petitioner for quite some time, Mr. Parmar, learned counsel for petitioner submits that since the Court is not inclined to interfere with the order of remand passed by the learned Additional Sessions Judge-2, Nagpur in Criminal Revision No.304/2019 filed by the present petitioner, he wishes to withdraw the present petition.
