PETITION FOR ANTICIPATORY BAIL Under Sec. 438 Cr.P.C.

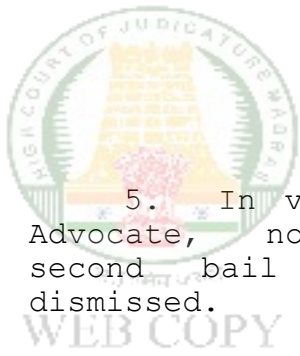
ORDER : The Court Made the following order :-

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent Police for the alleged offence under Sections 306 IPC r/w. Section 9 of the Child Marriage Restraint Act in Cr.No.381 of 2021 on the file of the respondent Police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that the petitioner is alleged to have performed love marriage with the defacto complainant's daughter and thereafter had love affair with another girl and when the same was questioned, he continuously harassed her, due to which, she committed suicide.

3. It is seen from records that this is the second bail petition filed by the petitioner. The previous order, dismissing the Criminal Original petition in Crl.O.P.No.13232 of 2021 was passed by this Court on 30.07.2021.

4. The learned Government Advocate (Crl. side) submitted that there is no change in circumstances after the previous order was passed on merits. Hence, the learned Government Advocate vehemently opposed to grant bail to the petitioner.



5. In view of the submission made by the learned Government Advocate, no change of circumstances arises for considering the second bail petition. Hence, this Criminal Original petition is dismissed.
