ORDER

The petitioner, who apprehends arrest at the hands of the respondent police for the alleged offences punishable under Sections 394 and 398 of IPC in Crime No.64 of 2021, on the file of the respondent police, seeks anticipatory bail.

2. The case of the prosecution is that on 13.02.2021, the mobile phone of the defacto complainant was snatched by the petitioner and other two persons. Hence, the complaint.

3. The learned counsel for the petitioner would submit that the petitioner is innocent and has not committed any such offence as alleged by the prosecution and he has been falsely implicated in this case. He would further submit that the co-accused was granted bail by this Court in Crl.O.P.No.6465 of 2021 dated 01.04.2021. Hence, he prays to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner.



4. The learned Additional Public Prosecutor would submit that the defacto complainant was attacked by the petitioner and other accused and he sustained grievous injury, due to which, 12 stitches has been put on his fore head. There is one previous case of similar nature pending against the petitioner. Hence, he vehemently opposed for grant of anticipatory bail to the petitioner.

5. Considering the facts and circumstances of the case and also the submissions made by both counsel, this Court is inclined to grant anticipatory bail to the petitioner with certain conditions.

6. Accordingly, the petitioner is ordered to be released on bail in the event of arrest or on his appearance, within a period of fifteen (15) days after lifting of lockdown or the commencement of the Court's normal functioning whichever is earlier, before the learned Judicial Magistrate, Thiruvottiyur, on condition that the petitioner shall execute a bond for a sum of Rs.10,000/- (Rupees Ten Thousand Only), with two sureties each for a like sum to the satisfaction of the respondent police or the police officer who intends to arrest or to the satisfaction of the learned Magistrate concerned and on further conditions that:

(a) The petitioner is directed to deposit a sum of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) to the credit of the Crime No.64 of 2021.

(b) the defacto complainant is permitted to withdraw the said deposit amount of Rs.15,000/- (Rupees Fifteen Thousand Only) on proper identification and acknowledgment;

(c) the petitioner and the sureties shall affix their photographs and left thumb impression in the surety bond and the Court concerned may obtain a copy of their Aadhar card or Bank pass Book to ensure their identity;

(d) the petitioner shall report before the respondent police on Tuesday and Saturday at 10.30 a.m., for a period of four weeks and thereafter, as and when required for an interrogation;

(e) the petitioner shall not tamper with evidence or witness either during investigation or trial;

(f) the petitioner shall not abscond either during investigation or trial;

(g) on breach of any of the aforesaid conditions, the learned Magistrate/ Trial Court is entitled to take appropriate action against the petitioner in accordance with law as if the conditions have been imposed and the petitioner released on bail by the learned



Magistrate/Trial Court himself as laid down by the Hon'ble Supreme Court in *P.K.Shaji Vs. State of Kerala [(2005) AIR SCW 5560]*; and;

(h) if the accused thereafter absconds, a fresh FIR can be registered under Section 229-A IPC.
