PRAYER in W.P.No.2708 of 2000: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to issue a Writ of Certiorarified Mandamus to call for the records comprised in the circular or of the first respondent dated Nil 02.1998 (signed on 25.2.1998) in Na.Ka.No.065/97 and of the second respondent dated 11.1.2000 in WDC No.D.11/287/99 and quash the same as illegal and unconstitutional and consequently direct the respondents to grant the building permit applied for by the petitioner for the construction No.115, Theagaraya Road, T.Nagar, Chennai 17 without in any manner seeking to demand and collect as precondition for grant of building licence any contribution from the petitioner so as to be paid to Secretary, Tamil Nadu Construction Workers Welfare Board, Chennai, which is illegal and unauthorised.

PRAYER in W.P.No.16848 of 2000: Writ Petition filed under Article 226 of the Constitution of India seeking to issue a Writ of Declaration to declare that the provisions of Section 8-A of the Tamil Nadu Manual Workers (Regulation of Employment and Conditions of Work) Act of 1982 (Act 33 of 1982) as inserted by the Admendment Act 26 of 1993 and the consequential Government Orders and the Scheme framed thereunder are illegal, arbitrary and ultra vires the provisions of the 1982 Act and the Scheme insofar as the petitioner is concerned.
